- 比賽共分為初級組及高級組進行：

初級組：中一至中三或同等程度學生（統計海報）
高級組：中四至中六或同等程度學生（報告書）

- 學生可以以個人身份或與同校同學組隊參賽
- 每隊人數不得超過六人
- 每位學生只可遞交一份習作，但每間學校的參賽習作數目則沒有限制

參賽習作的內容

初級組

- 參賽者須遞交一份**海報**
- 可自行設定研究主題，主題不設限制，參賽者或可參考下列建議：
 - 人口
 - 人口普查地區數據分析
 - 教育
 - 環境
 - 醫療
 - 對外貿易

參賽習作的內容

高級組

- 參賽者須遞交一份**報告書**
- 可自行設定研究主題，主題不設限制
- 研究題材應以探討本港各方面的**社會特色**（例如房屋、教育和社會福利等）或**經濟特色**（例如對外貿易、國民收入和經濟結構轉型等）為主

統計海報／報告書應選用的數據

- 應選擇切合研究主題的數據作研究
- 選用的數據須以官方或香港特別行政區政府的刊物或網站內的官方統計資料為主
 - 可瀏覽政府統計處網站(www.censtatd.gov.hk)以揀選適用的政府統計刊物或數據
 - 亦可選用其他刊物作為輔助資料來源
- 參賽者不得使用自行搜集的數據

分析和闡釋數據 及 陳示結果

- 應全面研究和分析所選用的數據
 - 本會鼓勵參賽者採用 **簡單易明** 的數據分析和統計推理方法，及盡量避免採用高深的統計方法
- 應將數據背後的事實和訊息充份描述出來，並適當地運用摘要的統計數字和圖表來陳示分析結果
- 論證和結論亦應以分析結果為依歸

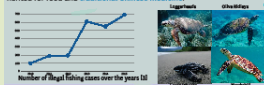
設計海報（初級組）

- 海報須闡述研究主題的主要分析過程及結果，以及相關的統計定義
- 必須以中文或英文撰寫，並把內容設計在A3大小(420x297mm)的紙張上
- 可運用繪畫或電腦繪圖設計海報
- 須遞交海報的電子版本
 - 電子版本須為PDF、PPT/PPTX或JPEG檔案
- 海報的數據來源及參考資料，均須在註腳或參考書目中說明，否則可能會被取消參賽資格

THREATS & SOLUTIONS

1. **Overharvesting and illegal trade**
Numerous sea turtles and dolphins are killed for their meat, medicine, and other purposes. The primary turtle species targeted for their shells include *loggerheads*, *olive ridleys*, *leatherbacks*, and *hawksbills*. Additionally, people hunt sea turtles for their meat and eggs, which serve as both food and a source of income. Chinese white dolphins are also hunted for food and traditional Chinese medicine.



What has the Chinese government done to solve this problem?

Construction and oyster farming must be prohibited in mainland China in 2020. Construction works and oyster farming in core and buffer areas are regulated in nearby waters, such that the ocean will not be polluted by such actions which disturb the dolphins. Therefore, eco-friendly construction methods must be adopted in nearby coastal waters. As stated in the graphs (A) below, after the laws made by the government, less areas of the oceans in China are for oyster farming.



5. **Oyster farming**
When the exact location of the oyster farm was determined, the dolphins and sea turtles around their use of that area after the farm was in place. Tracks of adult female dolphin movement near the oyster farm were less likely to enter the oyster farm itself than tracks of dolphin movement near an ecologically similar location where no oyster farm existed. But why do they choose somewhere further away from aquaculture interaction like oyster farming? Oyster farming includes death or injury through entanglement in gear, displacement, altered food chain, disruption of migration pathways, and human intervention. Therefore, dolphins and sea turtles avoid shellfish farms causing the number of these animals to decrease significantly.



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What can be done to solve this problem?

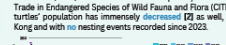
1. **Right now, all wild turtles in Hong Kong including sea turtles are "Protected Wild Animals" under the Wild Animals Protection Ordinance (Chapter 370).** Hunting, wilful disturbance, possession, sale or export of sea turtles including their nests and eggs are subject to a maximum fine of HK\$100,000 and an imprisonment of 1 year.
2. **The fine amount and length of imprisonment can be even increased in the future, giving a warning signal to those who do not follow the laws, overfishing and illegally trading Chinese White dolphins and sea turtles.**



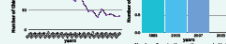
2. **HABITAT LOSS**
Bright lights from roads and buildings disorient hatchlings, while vehicles compact the sand, making nesting challenging for females. Onshore activities like land clearing and agricultural runoff damage essential feeding areas such as coral reefs and seagrass beds, leading to starvation and death among sea turtles. Chinese white dolphins typically feed in shallow coastal waters, usually no deeper than 10 meters. Coastal reclamation such as the Kai Tak Airport extension, Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge, and the Praya Reclamation Scheme disrupts their habitats and movements, causing stress and forcing them into less suitable areas, further threatening their breeding, nursery, and foraging grounds.



3. **Water Pollution**
The amount of E. coli in the water column has been high over the years in Hong Kong, raising the health threat of the dolphins and turtles. While E. coli is commonly associated with human health issues, its presence in marine environments can indicate pollution and the presence of harmful pathogens. Infected dolphins and sea turtles may suffer from injuries or health problems, which can sometimes lead to death. More than 50% (A) of the waters in Hong Kong have a high level of E. coli.



4. **E. coli levels in Hong Kong's waters from 2003-2023 (A)**



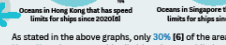
5. **Conclusion**
The health of sea turtles and Chinese White dolphins is crucial, but people are not fully aware of this situation. Urgent action is needed to address threats like pollution, coastal reclamation, overfishing, etc. by raising awareness, we can encourage sustainable practices and support policies that protect our beloved marine animals. Every action matters—whether it's reducing plastic use or taking good care of food waste, even small actions can make a big impact to the marine environment. Together, we can make a significant impact in saving our oceans. Let's all help Save the Marines!



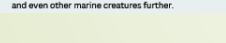
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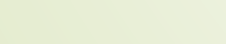
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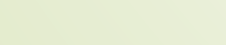
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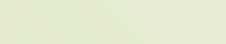
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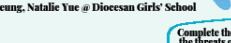


What has the government done to solve this problem?

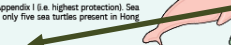
1. **The Hong Kong government has taken various measures to protect habitats less for Chinese white dolphins, including establishing marine reserves, enforcing environmental protection assessments for development projects, and introducing stricter regulations on coastal development. Additionally, they fund research to monitor dolphin populations and promote public awareness campaigns to educate the community about the importance of conserving these vulnerable species.**



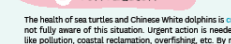
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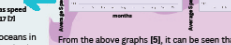
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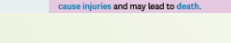
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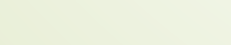
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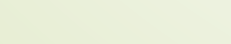
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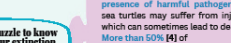


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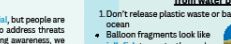
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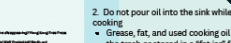
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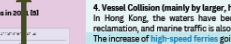
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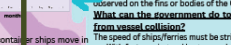
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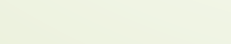
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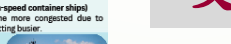
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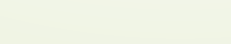

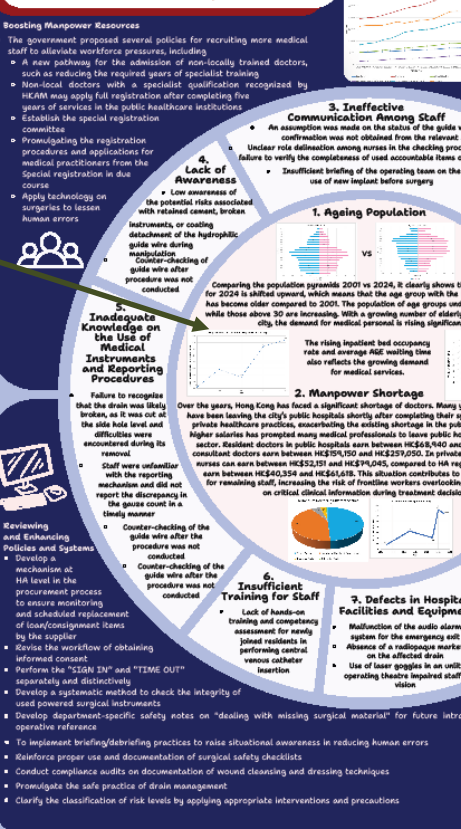
When Healing HURTS

The Hospital Authority introduced the Sentinel Event Policy on October 1, 2009, to enhance patient safety by consistently reporting serious medical incidents and learning from these events. The first Annual Report on Sentinel Events (SE) was published in January 2009. In 2020, the policy was expanded to include Serious Unintended Events (SUE). Sentinel Events are defined as unexpected occurrences that result in death or serious physical or psychological injury or the risk thereof. In contrast, Serious Unintended Events are incidents that lead to significant harm but may not meet the criteria for sentinel events. The key difference lies in their severity: Sentinel Events have the potential to cause death or irreversible harm, while Serious Unintended Events involve serious but less critical outcomes.



Causes and Follow-up Measures

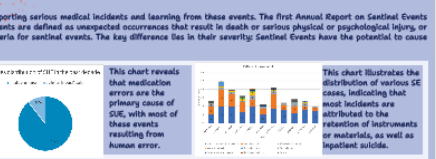


Medical negligence is a critical issue that demands greater attention as reducing instances of medical negligence can significantly lower preventable deaths. This poster emphasizes that human error is the primary cause of medical negligence. In Hong Kong, several factors contribute to this problem, including an ageing population, a shortage of medical staff, and high turnover rates. We have also compared Hong Kong's situation with that of other countries and explored solutions to these challenges. However, various stakeholders in Hong Kong are collaborating to enhance patient care through management support, system upgrades, and more.

Drawing on findings from the report "To Err is Human," we believe that learning from past mistakes and addressing potential risks can help reduce the rate of sentinel events. This commitment ensures that healing remains the primary focus of healthcare. We hope this poster raises awareness about the critical issue of medical negligence in Hong Kong, encouraging the government and healthcare professionals to take proactive steps to lower its occurrence for the safety and well-being of all patients.

This poster aims to shed light on medical negligence in Hong Kong. By analyzing trends and impacts of medical errors, examining various case studies, categorizing the contributing factors, and showcasing both implemented and potential solutions—while also comparing with other countries—we provide a more profound understanding of patient safety that can be achieved.



Impacts

According to the WHO, a significant number of patients are harmed or die each year due to unsafe healthcare, contributing to a substantial burden of death and disability worldwide. Evidence suggests that 134 million adverse events related to unsafe care occur in hospitals in low- and middle-income countries. A report released by the United States Institute of Medicine in 1999 extrapolated a death rate from incidents of adverse events in U.S. hospitals based on two earlier studies. It estimated that at least 44,000, and possibly as many as 98,000, people die in hospitals each year as a result of medical errors. This highlights the alarming reality that many individuals lose their lives due to medical errors.

International Comparison

The World Health Organization (WHO) reported in 2023 that approximately 1 in every 10 patients is harmed in healthcare, resulting in over 3 million deaths annually due to unsafe care. Furthermore, more than 50% of these harms could be prevented, with medication-related issues accounting for half of the harm.

Hong Kong's per capita doctor ratio lags behind that of other advanced economies. Currently, Hong Kong has a ratio of two doctors per 1,000 population, which is significantly lower than in Singapore (2.5), Japan (2.5), the United States (2.6), the United Kingdom (3.0), and Australia (3.8).

1 in 10 represents number of sentinel events (SE) to the population in the respective places. The table indicates that the United Kingdom has the highest rate of sentinel events (SE), followed by Hong Kong, with Australia having the lowest rate. Compared to a developed country like the United Kingdom, Hong Kong shows relatively good management of patient safety, instilling confidence in citizens regarding the medical system and fostering trust in Hong Kong's healthcare. However, it also highlights that there is still significant room for improvement in Hong Kong compared to Australia.

Equipment and facilities: Repair or upgrade the security alarm system and ensure regular preventive maintenance is in place.

Supervision: Suspend the use of Catheterisation technique.

- 指導老師可於確定研究主題和進行分析時提供指導及意見，但不應參與實質的研究工作，包括海報設計／報告書的編寫
- 一經發現，參賽作品會被降級或被取消參賽資格

海報及報告書的原創性

- 本會鼓勵參賽者自行創作海報／報告書中的圖畫及電腦繪圖。如有需要引用其他已公開發布的圖表，參賽者必須在該圖表註腳說明圖表出處，同時不得侵犯任何其他人士的知識產權
- 任何形式的抄襲，一經發現，會被取消參賽資格
- 如獲獎隊伍在領獎後被發現有抄襲情況，本會將會作出跟進並保留撤銷獎項的權利

港區國安法

- 參賽作品不應違反《港區國安法》

- 評審團將由大學教授及政府統計師組成
- 評審團經審議後，選出每個組別的優勝隊伍
- 面試將暫定於2026年4月25日（星期六）舉行
 - 只有入圍習作的參賽者獲邀出席
 - 若參賽者於2026年4月17日（星期五）前仍未獲邀參加，則可視作落選論
